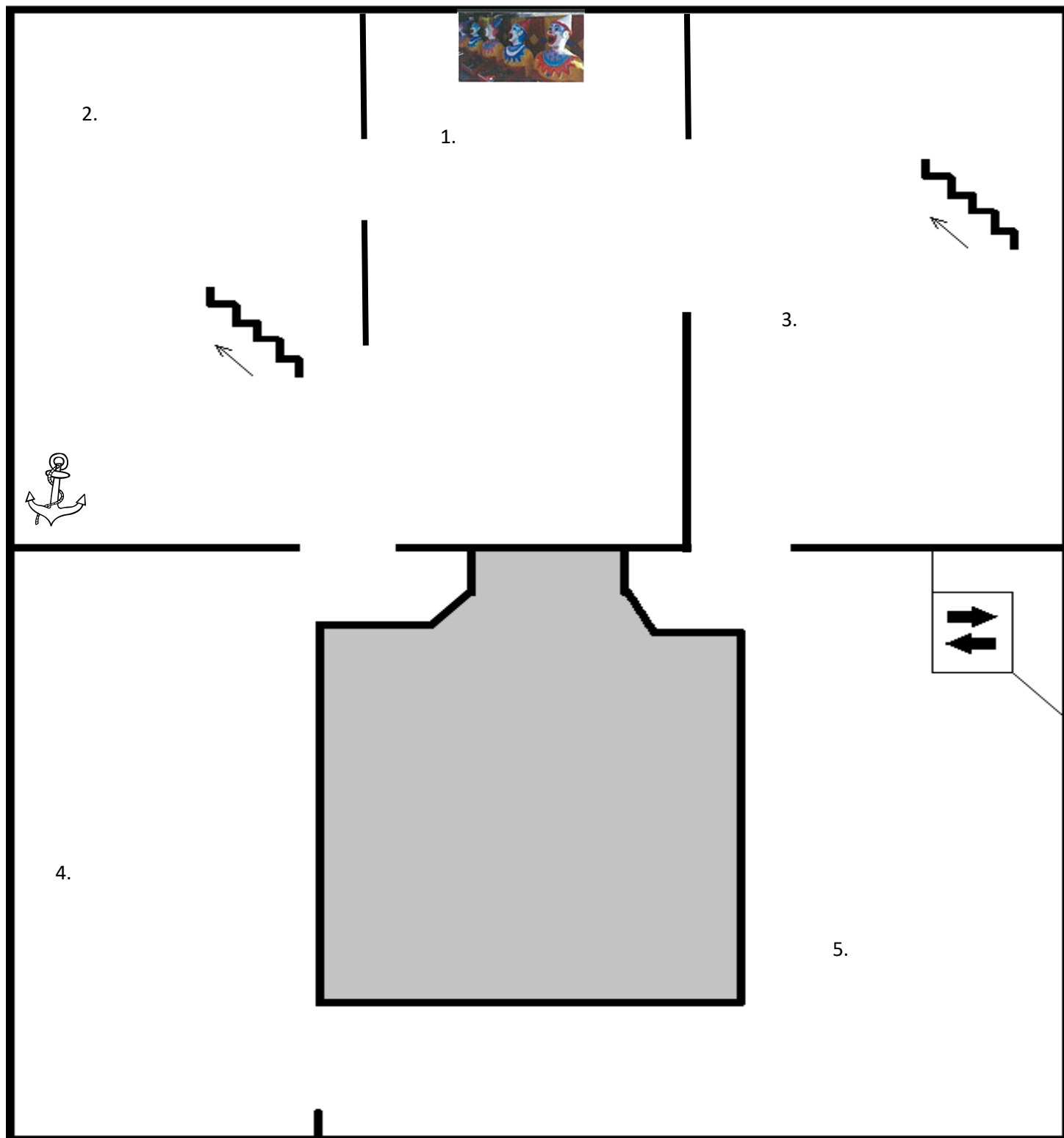




South Australian Maritime Museum Map – Upper Floor

Many places in South Australia have been named by early European explorers and occupants. Some places are named after significant people who were involved in the establishment of South Australia as a colony. In museums curators name the exhibitions.

Discussion: Did the Aboriginal people have names for different areas in Australia before European occupation?
